APPLICATION GUIDELINES AND FORM OF ASSESSMENT TAX REBATE SCHEME FOR HOUSE OWNERS: LOW CARBON GREEN CITY PETALING JAYA 2016

BACKGROUND

The Petaling Jaya City Council (Majlis Bandaraya Petaling Jaya or MBPJ for short) adopted the Low Carbon Cities Framework which was prepared by KeTTHA and MIP on 14 December 2010 as a guideline for Petaling Jaya to follow in its path to becoming a Low Carbon Green City. Subsequently, the Low Carbon-Green City Task Force of Petaling Jaya was established to develop action plans, policies and related programs. Incentive schemes in the form of tax rebates to environmental friendly and sustainable house owners in Petaling Jaya is one of the initiatives that have been approved and recommended by the MBPJ on 28th July 2011 for implementation. MBPJ became the first local authority in the continent of Asia to implement such a scheme. Subsequently, in November 2013, the scheme was awarded the "Green Apple Award" by The Green Organisation, London. A total of 527 people have applied for the scheme since 2011. Since the response was ever-increasing, the Council re-launched the scheme in 2016.

The scheme aims to promote an environmental friendly "green" lifestyle with respect to making Petaling Jaya a Low Carbon Green City. The Assessment Tax Rebate Scheme is offered to house owners who have taken the initiative in making their homes more green and environmental friendly in terms of energy, water, biodiversity, waste management and transportation.

CONDITIONS

1. This scheme is known as the Assessment Tax Rebate Scheme for residential house owners abiding to the Low Carbon Green City Petaling Jaya Framework.
2. The Assessment Tax Rebate Scheme is offered to house owners who are environmental friendly, green and sustainable with reference to the criteria in section III.
3. The scheme is only offered to house owners of individual residential property only and not that of corporates. These include detached houses, semi-detached, terraced houses, flats, condominiums and apartments, as well as service apartments. House owners should not have tax arrears with the council.
4. The maximum rebate awarded is 100% or RM500, whichever is lower for each individual house. House owners who have received a rebate in any year from 2011 may submit an application for another component criteria under the following conditions:-
 - (a) Only eco-friendly components and sustainable new green initiatives that have never been evaluated may be taken into consideration, **OR**

- (b) Components that have been evaluated in the previous year but have been given significant improvements, or at least 50 % (refer to details in Table 1 below).
5. Only house with owner self occupied is eligible to be considered. For tenanted house, owner must submit the application and approval is subjected to the consideration of Council upon recommendations by the Panel of experts.
 6. Applications must be submitted by using the application form provided by the council and approval is subjected to recommendation by a panel of experts appointed by the council.
 7. The following documents must be submitted together with the application form:-
 - a. **A copy of Identification Card**
 - b. **A copy of the latest assessments notice**
 - c. **A copies of electricity bills for latest last three (3) months**
 - d. **A copies of water bills for latest last three (3) months**
 8. For evaluation purposes, the owner must agree to show copies of the required documents submitted during visits by the Council or a member of the appointed experts for verification purposes, if necessary. The Council reserves the right to disqualify the application if the applicant fails to cooperate.
 9. The amount of approved rebate will be credited to the account of property in lieu of payment of the assessment tax for the first term of 2017.
 10. House owners will be notified by letter or in an assessment tax rebate presentation ceremony that will be held, if any.
 11. The Council's decision is final and the Council reserves the right to amend, supplement or adjust the terms set without prior notice.
 12. The closing date for applications for the year 2016 is on July 30, 2016.
 13.
